C. Presentation of the organisation

InnoEUsphere is an education and training organisation based in Larnaka, Cyprus, founded in 2022 and active across Europe as a partner in EU-funded cooperation projects and as a receiving organisation for learning mobility. The organisation specialises in the design and delivery of non-formal and informal learning programmes, youth work and youth mobility, participatory engagement processes and people-centred approaches that place learners, youth workers and communities at the heart of every initiative.

Its mission is to contribute to EU skills intelligence through smarter, people-centred education and training actions grounded in non-formal and informal learning methodologies, with an emphasis on digital transformation, sustainable competitiveness and resilience, from peer-led learning circles and co-creation workshops to community-based participatory processes.

Fields of activity: education and training (adult education, VET and non-formal learning); entrepreneurship, innovation and leadership; culture and the cultural and creative industries; social inclusion and women's empowerment; youth work and learning mobility; digital transformation; sustainability and circular economy; EU project design, management and quality assurance.

D. Activities and experience relevant to EU cooperation projects

InnoEUsphere has taken part in EU-funded cooperation projects since its foundation and its team has worked in EU funding since 2014, from proposal preparation to grant management and reporting under Erasmus+, Creative Europe, ESF+, CERV, Horizon Europe and Interreg. Within consortia it leads work packages on training design and capacity building, quality assurance and evaluation, and dissemination and communication, and it delivers administrative and financial management, reporting and audit-ready documentation under lump sum and budget-based grant models. Its certified trainers deliver non-formal learning on entrepreneurship, leadership, soft skills and digital competences, and its pilots in Cyprus reach fewer-opportunities adults, migrants and young people through local companies, schools and community organisations.

InnoEUsphere is also an experienced receiving organisation for learning mobility. It hosts the ALMA initiative (ESF+) in Larnaka, running two-month mobilities for young people aged 18 to 29 who are not in employment, education or training, each group accompanied by an in-house mobility mentor, and it hosts Erasmus+ groups of learners, educators and youth workers with full training and job-shadowing programmes, study visits and Europass-certified learning outcomes.

PM Agora: InnoEUsphere co-founded and co-organises PM Agora, the annual capacity building and co-creation event for EU project managers, together with the Academy of Entrepreneurship (EL) and T-hap (IT). It brings together

project managers, coordinators and funding experts from across Europe to share practice on consortium management, reporting and impact.

Networks and partnerships: InnoEUsphere is a strategic partner of the Larnaka2030 initiative, which secured the European Capital of Culture 2030 title for Larnaka; its Director was one of six core team members contracted to develop the official bid book from 2024. It is a strategic partner of the Circular Economy Alliance, a member of the Friends of the New European Bauhaus network since August 2023, and a member of the European Pact for Skills and the European Chemical Regions Network.
